The Problems:

Lack of uniformity in training is leading to confusion about scope and duration.

Insurers are often required to certify that all covered care will be delivered by a licensed clinician.

Insufficiently trained staff risk greater incidence of patient burns or injury.

Payment for therapies not performed solely by a D.C. may be disallowed.

If national standards are not established by the chiropractic profession, insurance regulators and providers may create their own policies.

The solution:

Standardized training and formal certification for chiropractic clinical assistants



Purpose

- Protect the public by ensuring safe, effective care
- Offer logistically feasible training and testing
- Promote reasonable uniformity
- Provide professional, portable, and fair certification

Program Design

Eligibility:

- At least 18 years of age
- High school diploma or equivalent
- Good moral character

Initial Fees:

- \$150 includes exam, certificate, badge, and 1st year of registration

Education:

- 24 hours from a PACE provider -OR-
- 24 hours from another provider (subject to review) -OR-
- 2,000 hours of experience -OR-
- Current member board registration

Exam:

- Online
- Created by NBCE

First Year:

- Earn 300 hours of practical clinical experience

Renewals:

- Every two years
- Requires 6 hours of CE
